

How to write an essay on literature?

So, we have already made sure that we need to study the topic carefully first. If it is multi-faceted, take your time, cover it completely - take one aspect, one problem, and reveal it. Try to get away from formulaic statements imposed in the textbook, take a look at the literary work in your own way. Let's imagine that this is not a novel or a story, but a real case from life that happened to your neighbors, friends, relatives. How would you feel about it then? How would you consider the actions of the heroes? Write about it. Imagine your vision of the situation.

Do a good job with the quotes. For each of your theses, there should be an argument from the book, confirmed by the author. You can go from the opposite - that is, remember the moments that hit you most of all, crashed into your memory, and then begin to write theses exactly under them.

Use associations, non-standard logic bindings, paradoxes.

Express your thoughts brightly, beautifully, artistically, use metaphors and comparisons, epithets and allegories, give examples from real life. On the pages of your essay, the heroes must "come to life", to become personified.

Make a logical conclusion from your reasoning.
